1. HARVESTING

Various materials are gathered from nature.

2. PREPARING

The materials are prepared to be used for crafting.

3. CRAFTING

Villagers carry out the crafting process to completion.

Cutting and collecting reeds

Digging clay from riverbank

Pick cotton from village fields and remove seeds

Plant is scrapped, split, cut to size, and dyed

Clay is sifted, conditioned, molded, and dried

Pull bolls onto strands, wind the spindle

Strips are woven together to form pattern

Carve or stamp, bake in kiln, and seal

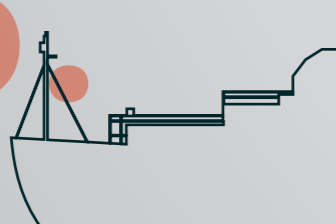
String loom and weave
